

COMMISSIONER MEETING
416 Broadway, Townsend, MT 59644
April 11, 2022

Commissioner Darrel Folkvord called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., Commissioners Mike Delger and Debi Randolph were also present.

Public comment: none.

Community Development Director Nichole Brown presented Boundary Relocation Catalfamo/Olson at 37 Missouri View Loop, Toston, MT. Frank Catalfamo offered comments. County Sanitarian Shawn Rowland offered comments. Commissioner Randolph moved to approve. Commissioner Delger seconded. Bill West, Lynett Koetz, Dan Turk, Russ Perkins, William Hagnas of Rendezvous Subdivision offered comments. Sanitarian Rowland requested a surveyor visit sight for drain. Acting County Attorney Jania Hatfield offered comments regarding covenants, aggregation, and boundary relocations. Commissioner Randolph moved table this decision until Monday April 18, 2022. Commissioner Delger seconded and carried.

MRL Bridge Replacement Floodplain Development Permit discussion. Montana Rial Link petitioned the County to do some repairs and replace some areas of the tracks west of Townsend. County Floodplain Administrator issued a Floodplain Development Permit. Tim Ravndal offered comments. Commissioner Delger moved to approve Floodplain Permit for Montana Rail Link. Commissioner Randolph seconded and carried.

Permafrost Resolution discussion. No money from the county to support this, rather, it is a grant in the amount of \$21,500.00. Tim Ravndal offered comments. Commissioner Randolph moved to approve signing the Budgetary Authority Resolution to allow Permafrost access the Big Sky Economic Development Trust Fund Grant in the total amount of \$21,500.00. Seconded by Commissioner Delger and carried.

Commissioner Randolph moved to approve the contract of Big Sky Economic Development Trust Fund signature certification form. Seconded by Commissioner Delger and carried.

Esther Fishbaugh presented Silos update. Finished with all the repairs on the main doc. Dredging project is finished.

Commissioner Delger moved to approve April 4, 2022, Minutes. Commissioner Randolph seconded and carried.

Commissioner Randolph moved to approve claims in the amount of \$89,362.59. Commissioner Delger seconded and carried.


