

COMMISSIONER MEETING

MARCH 11, 2020

Commissioner Darrel Folkvord called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Commissioner Mike Delger was also present. Commissioner Laura Obert was “working in Washington DC today on behalf on the Montana Board of Crime Control at the National Criminal Justice Association Policy Summit.”

Brandon Harris, Deputy Sheriff, presented the COPS grant request for approval. If approved, the \$250,000.00 grant will allow funding for 2 officers for three years. Commissioner Delger moved to approve the grant request. Motion seconded by Commissioner Folkvord and carried.

Mike Myers, Maintenance, presented two Homeland Security grant applications for approval, both will be 100% funded:

1. \$165,000.00 for an emergency generator for the detention center and courthouse. The current generator supplies limited power to the detention center, and none to the courthouse.
2. \$42,900.00 for security upgrades for the Sheriff’s department and the courthouse.

Commissioner Delger moved to approve the grant applications. Motion seconded by Commissioner Folkvord and carried.

Commissioner Delger moved to sign the DEQ land farm permit application to land farm the contaminated soil to be excavated from the old Grover’s Retail facility, which will be spread and monitored on county property. Motion seconded by Commissioner Folkvord and carried.

Ross Johnson was also in attendance.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:27 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for March 16, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.
