- a. Holloway Park Gazebo
  - i. Currently waiting on the engineer. Conduit is in the ground and ended up being 140 feet.
     The \$551.85 cost was approved and will be taken out of the Parks & Recreation fund.
  - ii. Irrigation and grass will be installed next spring.
  - iii. Successful Grand Opening.

### b. Connors' Field Infrastructure

- i. Nichole Brown received a bid from Rock Hard Construction for \$20,087 for flat work which would include the removal of the old concrete and pour/finish of the new concrete. Nichole would like to see this finished this calendar year which will help with the transition for the ADA toilet installation.
- ii. The installation of the vault toilet is estimated at \$18,240. More grants would be available if the field was handicapped accessible. The decision would be to pay for one project and that project will help to fund the other. The Missoula Concrete bid was approved plus/minus 10 percent; will need a new bid since the last one expired.
- iii. Nichole will submit a request to the Trust Board on behalf of the Parks & Recreation Board for matching funds. A \$125 fee is to be paid to DNRC for the water right filing.
- iv. Board is funded by donation and/or the monies received from subdivision development.

- c. Swimming Pool Enhancement/Sustainability
  - i. Adam talked with Tim Rauser, City of Townsend Foreman who will inspect the well at some point this winter and will update Adam with the findings.
- d. Folf Course
  - i. Adam received and email from the neighbors discussing the land transfer; the property cannot be traded.
