

## CONSENT TO AND WAIVER OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Broadwater County are Clients of the law firm Silverman Law Office, PLLC (“Law Firm”). Law Firm has been requested by Clients to assist in handling the review of construction contracts with various construction companies. Clients each agree that Law Firm represents them in this and other various matters and consent to and waive any claim of conflict of interest as a result of Law Firm’s representation of Broadwater County and its contract review needs and Bridger Brewing and its business needs. The Law Firm is not representing Bridger Brewing in its potential donation of real estate to Broadwater County.

Accordingly, by signing this letter, Clients consent to Law Firm’s representation on the terms set forth in this letter and authorize Law Firm to disclose to each of the other parties any information relating to the representation to the extent Law Firm reasonably believes is necessary to comply with Rule 1.7 of the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct.
