Subject: Reimbursement of future Corrective Action costs associated with the Department of Environmental Quality petroleum release #1632, Former Grover Exxon., 417 Broadway St., Townsend, MT, (DEQ Facility #0407957, TID 18053).

Dear Commissioners:

As of this date, the Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Board (PTRCB) has reimbursed \$340,869.42 in costs associated with the corrective action directed by the Department of Environmental Quality and completed by your environmental consultants. The Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Board (PTRCB) determined the release was **eligible** for financial assistance on April 3, 1995 under Title 75, chapter 11-307 MCA.

The Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Fund (Fund) is a reimbursement fund. This release had a co-payment consisting of 50% of the first \$35,000.00 of eligible costs. Because the co-payment has been met, the owner will receive 100% of all future **eligible** costs up to a maximum total reimbursement of \$982,500.00.
